East Keffolds (WA/2025/00354 – LBC application) - Objection

The Haslemere Society wishes to object to this LBC application on the grounds given below. Note that we do not object to the principle of adding an extension to the building.

1. The north western wall of the existing utility room attached to the side elevation of the listed building forms part of the original building, as seen on page 14 of the DAS. The wall and openings on all elevations of this wing should ideally be retained where the openings are historic and the original roof form shown on page 14 of the DAS should ideally be retained. The north east elevation appears more altered and is perhaps a more suitable location for an extension to abut the listed building.
2. Internally, there have been some minor changes to the original plan form over time, but the original plan form of the service rooms remains legible. The proposed scheme would almost entirely erase any remaining evidence of the configuration of the original service rooms.
